As we come to the end of our distance learning period I want to first thank you for all you've done to continue learning at home while school has been closed.

The distance learning program has required the use of school-provided Chromebooks and chargers. At this time we need for you to return the Chromebooks and chargers to school so that we can inventory them, update software, and prepare them for use in the fall.

Chromebooks may be dropped off at any location: the lower school at 459 Promenade St, the middle school at 30 Barton St, and the upper school at 544 Elmwood Ave at the following dates/times:

- Wednesday, June 17 at 9:00 am - 12:00 pm
- Wednesday, June 17 at 3:00 pm - 6:00 pm
- Thursday, June 18 at 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm

Please observe the tape marking six feet distance to meet social distancing guidelines. Please wear a face mask or cloth covering.

Lower School students will also be able to pick up their Super Soaker water toys during these times at the lower school location, too!

Parents and students will be able to retrieve belongings left in school after returning the the Chromebook and charger by joining a line at a separate entrance and following a one-way enter/exit pattern, provided that you:

- Wear a face mask or cloth covering
- Respond to reopening Rhode Island COVID-19 Screening Tool checklist questionnaire
- Maintain physical distancing
