

Dear Paul Cuffee School Families:

As you have heard, Governor Raimondo has announced that students will participate in distance learning days for the next two weeks, and likely for a period longer than that. Your teachers have been working hard to set up coursework using Google Classroom. You will need an internet-connected device and a home internet connection in order to complete distance learning.

Upper school students who may be missing a Chromebook are directed to contact their advisors. Upper School students who do not have a home internet connection are also directed to contact their advisors.

All lower and middle school students are eligible to receive a Chromebook, charger and home internet connection. Even if you have an internet-connected device at home you are welcome to take a school-issued Chromebook. We will be providing two sessions for families to pick up their Chromebooks: 12:00-3:00 PM on Friday and 8:00-11:00 AM on Saturday. Families with last names beginning with A-M are requested to arrive between 12:00-1:30 on Friday or between 9:30-11:00 AM Saturday. Families with last names beginning with N-Z are requested to arrive between 1:30-3:00 PM on Friday or between 8:00-9:30 AM on Saturday. You will be asked to stay in your vehicle. Cars should enter Rathbone St from Valley St only. Cars attempting to enter Rathbone St from Promenade St will be detoured.

If there are special circumstances preventing you from coming to the School then you should contact your child's advisor and the School will work with you to make special arrangements.
